Sub: **Administrative Approval for the project “Allied works in the form of upstream protection work in connection with improvement and strengthening of road over crest of Kangsabati & Kumari Dam in Khatra & Ranibundh Blocks in Bankura District” under Kangsabati Canal Division No. II bearing Scheme ID: IW/CSP-223/2016-17 out of Core State Plan Budget Provision of this Department, subordinate to Demand No. 32, contained in B.P No. 20 during the current financial year of 2016-17.**

The undersigned is directed to say that the Governor has been pleased to accord Administrative Approval for the project *“Allied works in the form of upstream protection work in connection with improvement and strengthening of road over crest of Kangsabati & Kumari Dam in Khatra & Ranibundh Blocks in Bankura District”* at an estimated cost of ₹ 199.18 lakh (*Rupees One nine nine point one eight lakh*) only out of Core State Plan (Voted) Budget of Irrigation & Waterways Department, subordinate to **Demand No. 32** as contained in B.P No. 20 during the current financial year of 2016-17. The following guidelines as applicable may be completed prior to implementation:

1. That all Tender formalities as per Provisions of Rule 47 of WBFR as amended vide FD Notification No. 5400-F(Y) Dated 25-06-2012 and other related orders in this respect will be followed for selection of the contractors/suppliers.
2. That the instant project does not overlap with any other Central or State Sector Scheme undertaken by this or other Department of the State Government.
3. That the competent authority shall ensure that the executing authority has the authority to take up the work on the land in question like NOC from the respective Local Bodies etc. [Ref - FD Notification No. 10184-F(A-II) dated 13-12-2012].
