M E M O R A N D U M

“Request for Expression of Interest” (REoI) has since been published on 13 February 2017 for the Consultancy Services for “Preparation of feasibility study, detailed engineering, design and bidding documents for irrigation rejuvenation and flood management in the Damodar Command areas and Lower Damodar Sub-basin in the State of West Bengal in India” in connection with the “West Bengal Major Irrigation and Flood Management Project” (WBMIFMP), jointly financed by the World Bank (WB) and Asian Infrastructure Development Bank (AIIB).

2. Request for Proposal (RFP) would be issued only to the shortlisted Consultants to be selected from the REoI and enable them to submit the technical as well as financial proposal. Final selection would be made from among the eligible Consultants submitting the RFP, following Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method.

3. The process of procurement of Consultants in general and evaluation of offers in particular would have to be done in accordance with the procedures and guidelines of the WB, so as to avail the facility of retroactive financing (i.e. subsequent reimbursement of expenditure incurred now by the State Government, after signing of loan agreement with the banks).

4. Accordingly, it has been decided to constitute a Departmental Bid Evaluation Committee (DBEC) to evaluate proposals relating to all consultancy services associated with the WBMIFMP.

5. Composition of the Committee would be as under, which may be modified suitably, once the full fledged Project Management Units are set up for this Project.
