Agenda: Short listing of additional projects in conformity with approved allocation under Core State Plan budget during the current financial year of 2017-18.

Secretary took the chair. Financial Advisor, Chief Engineer (North), Chief Engineer (Design & Research) and other officers remained present.

The following were discussed:

1. Technically sanctioned DPR of 3 new schemes at an aggregate estimated cost of Rs 14.77 Crore were initially placed before the DSC for consideration. Subsequently one more scheme of Chief Engineer (North) listed under SI 3 was included during the meeting.
2. The complete list of 4 schemes in attached as Annexure.
3. The DSC advised the Chief Engineer (North) that the scheme under SI. No. 1 of the Annexure should be accorded revised technical sanction for tender invitation only after observation of 2017 post monsoon bed levels and bank profiles.
4. The DSC advised the Chief Engineer (Design & Research) that the scheme under SI. No. 4 of the Annexure should be accorded revised technical sanction and tendered only after ensuring that brick materials salvaged after dismantling the existing dilapidated boundary wall are re-used in the sub-base course for the proposed road construction.
5. Technical clearance of the committee of Chief Engineers for the scheme under SI 3 has been reported to have been obtained.

6. Chief Engineer (South West) certified that there is no duplication of proposals with other sources of funding. All the schemes have been selected on the basis of prioritised ground requirements within approved allocation.
7. Finally all 4 no. of schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 19.00 crore were cleared by the DSC for inclusion under Core State Plan Budget of this Department during the current financial year of 2017-18.
