GOVERNMENT OF WEST BENGAL

NOTIFICATION.

No. 57-17th. May 1957.- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased to make, in supersession of all previous rules issued on the subject the following rules for the regulation of recruitment to the posts of Chief Research Officers, Research Officers and Assistant Research Officers in the River Research Institute, West Bengal, under the Department of Irrigation & Waterways, Government of West Bengal, namely :-

Rules for the regulation of recruitment to the posts of Chief Research Officers, Research Officers and Assistant Research Officers in the River Research Institute, West Bengal under the Department of Irrigation & Waterways, Government of West Bengal.

1. These rules shall apply to the posts of Chief Research Officers, Research Officers and Assistant Research Officers in the River Research Institute, West Bengal, and shall take effect from the 1st April, 1957.

PART - I - CADRE.

2. The posts of Chief Research Officers, Research Officers & Assistant Research Officers in the River Research Institute, West Bengal, shall be gazetted posts and shall constitute a separate cadre in the West Bengal General Service.

3. The scale of pay for the different posts shall be as follows :-  
1) Chief Research Officers : Rs. 350-30-680-40-1200 (E.B. after 10th and 18th Stages). Higher initial pay upto Rs. 650/- per month may be granted to direct recruits on the basis of age in deserving cases.

ii) Research Officers : Rs. 250-25-850 (E.B. after 12th stage) Higher initial pay may be granted to direct recruits on the basis of age and qualifications in deserving cases.

iii) Assistant Research Officers : Rs. 200-10-420-15-450 (E.B. after 10th and 18th Stages).

4. The existing six permanent Technical Sections of the River Research Institute, West Bengal, shall constitute three separate groups as detailed below :-

Group-A	Group-B	Group-C.
1) River Model Section	1) Soil Mechanics Sec.	1) Statistical sec.
ii) Tidal Model section	ii) Chemical sec.	
iii) Physical Section.		

5. Any one of the existing three permanent posts of Research Officers in Group-A and any one of the existing two permanent posts of Research Officers in Group-B shall be convertible, as and when necessary, to a permanent post of Chief Research Officer in the respective Group. Thus, there shall be one permanent post of Chief Research Officer and two permanent posts of Research Officers in Group-A, one permanent post of Chief Research Officer and one permanent post of Research Officer in Group-B and only one permanent post of Research Officer in Group-C.

PART-II, RULES OF RECRUITMENT  
Chief Research Officers.

- 6(1) Method of recruitment- Recruitment to the post of Chief Research Officers shall be made -  
either (a) by promotion from the posts of Research Officers in the River Research Institute, West Bengal, within the same Group provided that the candidate is found fit in all respects for the higher post; or (B) by selection (direct recruitment) departmental candidates being allowed to apply.
- (ii) Appointing Authority- Government on the recommendation of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal.
- iii) Qualifications for direct recruitment- I. Chief Research Officer for the River Model, the tidal Model and the Physical Sections (GrA).
  - (1) A first class degree in Civil Engineering or a First Class M.Sc. or Doctorate degree in Applied Mathematics or in any branch of Physical
  - (2) Five years' experience of research or of practical work in Irrigation or 'Hydraulic Engineering'.
  - (3) Age ordinarily not above 35 years.
- II. Chief Research Officer for the Soil Mechanics and the Chemical Sections (Group-B).
  - 1) A first class degree in Civil Engineering or a first class M.Sc. or Doctorate degree in any branch of Chemistry.
  - 2) Five years' experience of research or of practical work in Irrigation or Hydraulic Engineering.
  - 3) Age ordinarily not above 35 years.

Research Officers.

- \*7.(1) Method of recruitment.- Recruitment to the posts of Research Officers shall be made -  
either (a):  
by promotion from the posts of Assistant Research Officer in the River Research Institute, West Bengal, within the same group provided that the candidate is found fit in all respects for the higher post;  
(b) by selection (direct recruitment) departmental candidates being allowed to apply; or  
(c) by deputation of permanent officers of the West Bengal Service of Engineers (Irrigation).
- (ii) Appointing Authority - Government on the recommendation of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal.
- iii) Qualifications for direct recruitment.- I. Research Officer for the River Model Section-
  - 1) A first class degree in Civil Engineering or a first class M.Sc. or Doctorate degree in Applied Mathematics or in any branch of Physical
  - 2) Age ordinarily not above 27 years.
- II. Research Officer for the Tidal Model Section-
  - 1) A first class degree in Civil Engineering / a first class M.Sc. or Doctorate degree in Applied Mathematics or in any branch of Physical
  - 2) Age ordinarily not above 27 years.

- III. Research Officer for the Physics Section-
- 1) A first class M.Sc. or Doctorate degree in any branch of Physics.
  - 2) Age ordinarily not above 27 years.
- IV. Research Officer for the Chemical Section-
- 1) A first class M.Sc. or Doctorate degree in any branch of Chemistry
  - 2) Age ordinarily not above 27 years.
- \*\*V. Research Officer for the Statistical Section-
- 1) A first class Master's degree or Doctorate degree in Statistics or Applied Mathematics with specialisation in Statistics or Pure or Applied Mathematics with Post-Graduate training in Statistics.
  - 2) Age ordinarily not above 27 years.
- VI. Research Officer for the Soil Mechanics Section.
- 1) A first class degree in Civil Engineering.
  - 2) Age ordinarily not above 27 years.
- Assistant Research Officer.
- \*\*\*1) Method of recruitment.-Recruitment to the post of Assistant Research Officers shall be made-
- either:
- a) by promotion from the posts of Research Assistants in the River Research Institute, West Bengal, within the same group with at least five yrs service in that post, provided that the candidate is found fit in all respects for the higher post; or
  - b) by Selection (direct recruitment) departmental candidates being allowed to apply.
- ii) Appointing authority.-Government on the recommendations of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal.
- iii) Qualifications for direct recruitment.-I. Assistant Research Officers for the Physical Section-
- 1) A first class M.Sc. or Doctorate degree or a Second class M.Sc. with first class Honours degree in any branch of Physics.
  - 2) Age ordinarily not above 27 years.
- II. Assistant Research Officer for the Chemical Section-
- 1) A first class M.Sc. or Doctorate degree or a Second class M.Sc. with first class Honours degree in any branch of Chemistry.
  - 2) Age ordinarily not above 27 years.
- III. Assistant Research Officer for the Soil Mechanics Section-
- 1) A degree in Civil Engineering or a first class M.Sc. or Doctorate degree or a Second class M.Sc. with first class Honours degree in pure Physics or Pure Chemistry.
  - 2) Age ordinarily not above 27 years.

PART-II-GENERAL.

As regards matters not provided for in the preceding rule, the general provisions of the Bengal General Service Recruitment, Rules shall apply.

The following new clause shall be added below clause IV under sub-rule (iii) of rule 8 of the said rules, namely:-

“V. Assistant Research Officer for the Hydraulics Section:-

(1) A degree in Civil Engineering or a first class M.Sc. Degree or a Doctorate degree or Second Class M.Sc. degree with at least a Second Class Honours degree in Applied Mathematics or in any branch of Physics.

(2) Age not ordinarily above 27 years.”

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the constitution of India, the Governor has been pleased to make the following amendment in the rules for the regulation of recruitment to the posts of Chief Research Officers, Research Officers and Assistant Research Officers in the River Research Institute, West Bengal under the department of Irrigation and Waterways, Government of West Bengal, promulgated with that Department notification No. 57 dated 17<sup>th</sup>. May, 1957, as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), namely :-

**AMENDMENT**

In sub-rule(iii) of rule 7 of the said rules, for clause V substitute the following clause, namely :-

“ V. Research Officer for the Statistical Section :

- (1) A second class Master's degree or a Doctorate degree in Statistics or Pure Mathematics or Applied Mathematics of a recognized University or equivalent.
- (2) Two year's experience of Numerical Analysis and Statistical Methods.
- (3) Age – Not more than 30 years, relaxable for well qualified candidates.”

No. 155 -30<sup>th</sup> June 1976 – In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in super session of all previous rules on the subject, the governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules for the regulation of recruitment to the posts of Senior Research Assistant (Hydraulics ) and Research Assistant in the River Research Institute, West Bengal, under the department of Irrigation and Waterways, Government of west Bengal namely.

Rules for the regulation of recruitment to posts of Senior Research Assistant (Hydraulics) and Research Assistant in the River Research Institute, West Bengal under the Department of Irrigation and waterways, government of West Bengal.

1. These rules shall apply to recruitment to the posts of Senior Research Assistant (Hydraulics) and Research Assistants in the River Research Institute, West Bengal under in the West Bengal subordinate Service and shall take effect from the date of this notification.

**PART – I**

**RULES FOR RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF SENIOR RESEARCH ASSISTANT**  
**(HYDRAULICS – GROUP – ‘A’)**

- 2 (1) **Method of recruitment**: Recruitment to the post of Senior Research Assistant (Hydraulics, Group- ‘A’) shall be made:-
  - (a) by promotion from the holders of the posts of the permanent Research Assistants in the Hydraulics Section (Group- ‘A’) of the River Research Institute, West Bengal; or
  - (b) by selection ( direct recruitment) departmental candidates being eligible to apply.
- (2) **Appointing authority**: The Director, River Research Institute, West Bengal who shall appoint the candidates of the recommendation of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal.
- (3) **Qualifications for direct recruitment**:-
  - (a) **Essential** A degree in Civil Engineering of a recognized University or an M.Sc. degree in Applied Mathematics or in any branch of Physics.
  - (b) **Desirable**: Experience in Hydraulics Research.
- (4) **Age**: Ordinarily not more than 30 years relaxable for departmental candidates holding substantive appointment in the River Research Institute, West Bengal to the extent of their actual period of continuous service in any capacity in technical post or posts in that Institute and also for candidates otherwise well - qualified and experienced.

**PART – II**

**RULES FOR RECRUITMENT TO POSTS OF RESEARCH ASSISTANT IN THE**  
**DIFFERENT SECTIONS OF THE RIVER RESEARCH INSTITUTE, WEST**  
**BENGAL**

- 3.(1) **Method of recruitment ( for all posts)**: Recruitment to posts of Research Assistant in the different sections shall be made by selection (direct recruitment )departmental candidates being eligible to apply.
- (2) **Appointing authority**:- The Director, River Research Institute, West Bengal who shall appoint the candidates on the recommendation of the Public Service Commission , West Bengal.

**(3) Qualifications for direct recruitment :-**

**(a) Research Assistant (Hydraulic – Model Experiments – Group ‘A’)**

**Essential:** A B.Sc. degree with Mathematics of Physics as one of the subjects from a recognized University

**Desirable:** Experience in statistical work analysis of silt data and use of siltometers.

**(b) Research Assistant (Physics – Group ‘A’)**

**Essential:** A B.Sc. degree with Physics as one of the subjects from a recognized University.

**Desirable:** Experience in research work in Physics.

**(c) Research Assistant (Chemistry – Group ‘B’)**

**Essential:** A degree with Chemistry as one of the subjects from a recognized University.

**Desirable:** Experience in research work in Chemistry.

**(d) Research Assistant (Soil Mechanics – Group ‘B’)**

**Essential:** A B.Sc. degree with Chemistry or Physics as one of the subjects from a recognized University

**Desirable:** Experience in a Soil Mechanics Laboratory.

**(e) Research Assistant (Statistics – Group ‘C’)**

**Essential:** A B.Sc. degree with Mathematics as one of the subjects from a recognized University.

**Desirable:** Training and experience in Statistics work.

**Age (for all posts):** Ordinarily not more than 30 years, relaxable for departmental candidates holding substantive appointment on the River Research Institute, West Bengal to the extent of their actual period of continuous service in any capacity in technical post or posts in that Institute and also candidates otherwise well-qualified and experienced.

**PART – III**

4. As regards matters not provided for in the preceding rules, the general provisions of the West Bengal Subordinate Service (General Recruitment) Rules 1936, shall apply in so far as they are not inconsistent with the provisions of the preceding rules.
