

**Minutes of the Pre-Bid Meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021 in NIC Conference  
Hall, Ground Floor, Jalsampad Bhavan, Salt Lake City, Kolkata – 700 091  
in connection with the work: -**

**“Improvement of Kana Damodar from 0.00 Km to 52.791 Km including all its appurtenant canals within the reach.” - Package-IRR-14 - comprising four lots.**

**Lot - 1: “Improvement of Kana Damodar from 0.00 Km to 34.38 Km including all its appurtenant canals within the reach except D-1 canal.”**

**Lot - 2: “Improvement of D-1 canal of Kana Damodar from 0.00 Km to 48.77 Km including all its appurtenant canals within the reach.”**

**Lot - 3: “Improvement of D-2 canal of Kana Damodar from 4.27 Km to 29.17 Km including all its appurtenant canals within the reach.”**

**Lot - 4: “Improvement of Kana Damodar from 34.38 Km to 52.791 Km and D-2 canal of Kana Damodar from 0.00 Km to 4.27 Km including all their appurtenant canals within the reach.”**

The meeting started at 04:00 pm on 30/11/2021 with Sri D. Sengupta, Chief Engineer & Project Director, SPMU, WBMIFMP, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate, Govt. of West Bengal on Chair.


At the onset, the CE & PD appraised the Bidders about the Bid Securities, Affidavit regarding correctness of information along with different clauses of ITB & BDS, brief description about the work, different component of Work and Contractor’s ESHS-MSIP of Bid Document.

Many of the small local bidders raised queries and concern about the high requirement value of AACT in the Qualification Criteria. The bidders requested the Employer to consider reduction in the value of AACT ranging from 100% to 125% of the Estimated Cost for all the four Lots of the IRR-14. This will enable them to qualify and participate for the Bid Package IRR-14. Bidders were informed, clarification will be provided shortly, after having consultation with the World Bank and if required, the subsequent Corrigendum to this effect will be issued.

It was re-iterated here that minutes of Pre-Bid meeting would be duly uploaded in NIC portal and it would not be the part of the Contract Documents.
