**Sub: Administrative Approval for the project 'Improvement of Banka river by de-siltation & re-sectioning including protection work in between km 54.66 to km 56.46 in Burdwan Municipality, P.S BurdwanSadar, District Burdwan under Damodar Canals Division bearing Scheme ID No. IW/CSP-270/2015-16 out of Core State Plan (Voted) Budget Provision of this Department, subordinate to Demand No. 32, contained in B.P No. 20 during the current financial year of 2015-16.**

The undersigned is directed to say that a proposal for execution of a project for **'Improvement of Banka river by de-siltation & re-sectioning including protection work in between km 54.66 to km 56.46 in Burdwan Municipality, P.S BurdwanSadar, District Burdwan** at an estimated cost of Rs 493.71 lakh (**Rupees Four nine three point seven one lakh**) only to be executed by Damodar Canals Division has been received in this Department. It has been further agreed that Burdwan Development Authority, a statutory organisation under Govt. of West Bengal would bear a sum of Rs 200.00 lakh and the remaining sum of Rs 293.71 lakh would be borne out of Core State Plan (Voted) Budget Provision of Irrigation & Waterways Department.

The balance sum of ₹ 100.00 lakh would be sought by Executive Engineer, Damodar Canals Division, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate from Burdwan Development Authority upon submission of utilisation certificate of the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment of release during the next financial year of 2016-17 or after accrual of financial liabilities against the said project.

He is requested to direct the concerned Superintending Engineer and Executive Engineer to take up execution of the said project in conformity with approved phasing of expenditure and to come up with the proposal of release of fund in Format-A (Modified) for the portion of work included under Core State Plan.
