2. Procedure for collecting Latitude and Longitude of mouzas is detailed below –
- To click <https://www.maps.google.com>
  - Convert Map to 'Earth'
  - Search/ Type name of mouza
  - Right click on mouza
  - Mouza boundary will be displayed on the map in red colour
  - Right Click on terminal points and left click on 'what's here' on those terminal points to find out latitude and longitude of a point

3. While preparing such list, the same pertaining to STQP, already published with our Notification No. 193 dt. 23.09.2016 (given in the Archive Link of Notification area of our Departmental Website, [www.wbiwd.gov.in](http://www.wbiwd.gov.in)) may be consulted and updated, if necessary.
4. The information as available with the District Land & Land Reforms Offices covering LTML areas are required to be compiled with and a District – wise comprehensive list may be prepared. It is requested to depute designated officers to collect the LTML lists from the District Level Offices of the land & Land Reforms Department.
5. The said compiled list is required to be submitted to the concerned District Magistrates within three weeks from the receipt of information on LTML locations, under intimation to this Department.
