NOTIFICATION

No.31-W/2022-2023

Dated, 7th February, 2023

With a view to bring an uniform law and administrative structure in the country for ensuring dam safety, the Dam Safety Act, 2021 has been introduced for surveillance, inspection, operation and maintenance of all specified dams in the country to ensure their safe functioning.

- 2. As per provisions of this Act State Committee on Dam Safety (SCDS) and State Dam Safety Organisation (SDSO) have been constituted in the state of West Bengal. Apart from this a separate Dam Safety Unit (DSU) for each of the specified dam is required to be constituted in terms of Chapter VII of section 30 of Dam Safety Act, 2021 (No.41 of 2021).
- 3. In exercise of the powers conferred by Chapter VII of section 30 of Dam Safety Act, 2021 (No.41 of 2021), the Irrigation & Waterways Department, Government of West Bengal hereby constitutes the Dam Safety Unit (DSU) for each of the specified dam under their jurisdiction with the composition as stated here under: -
- (i) The concerned Executive Engineer (Civil) Dam owner & Team Leader
 Irrigation & Waterways Directorate

- (ii) The concerned Assistant Engineer (Civil) Member

 Government of West Bengal
- 4. The Director, Dam Safety Organization, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate shall nominate his representative in the rank of Assistant Director (Civil), DSO for each of the 'Specified Dam'. The concerned Superintending Engineer, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate shall issue matching Order for each of the 'Specified Dam' under his jurisdiction, to declare 'Dam Owner' and individual Dam Safety Unit.

The Roles and functions of Dam Safety Unit will be to:-

- 5. Every 'Dam Owner' of a 'Specified dam' shall undertake every year, through their 'Dam Safety Unit', a pre-monsoon and post-monsoon inspections in respect of each such dam.
- 6. Every 'Dam Owner' of a 'Specified dam' shall inspect or cause to be inspected every specified dam by the 'Dam Safety Unit', during and after every flood, earthquake or any other natural or man-made calamities, or if any sign of distress or unusual behaviour is noticed in the dam.
- 7. Every 'Dam Owner' of a 'Specified dam' shall, -
 - (a) carry out all inspections referred to in Cl.5 and Cl.6 above in accordance with the guidelines and check-lists as may be specified by the regulations;
 - (b) station or depute his representative at each of the 'Specified dam' site throughout the monsoon period, such engineers and other technical personnel, as may be decided, in consultation with the 'State Dam Safety Organization';
 - Provided that the engineers and other technical personnel shall be required to be stationed at their respective dam sites during entire period of emergency following any other natural or man-made calamity that may create distress conditions in the dam; and

- (c) forward the inspection report by the 'Dam Safety Unit' to the State Dam Safety Organization, which shall analyse the report and submit comments on the deficiency and remedial measures, if any, to the owner of the 'Specified dam'.
- 7. Every 'Dam Owner' of a 'Specified dam' shall maintain a record of readings of the instrumentations already there in the Specified Dam and forward the analysis of such readings to the State Dam Safety Organisation, in the form, manner and at such interval as may be specified by the regulations.
- 8. Every 'Dam Owner' of a 'Specified dam' shall collect, compile, process and store data from the hydro-meteorological station in the vicinity of each 'Specified dam'.
- 9. In the case of every 'Specified dam', having a height of thirty metres or above or falling under such seismic zone, as may be specified by the regulations, the owner of the specified dam shall establish a seismological station in the vicinity of each such dam for recording micro and strong motion earthquakes and such other data as may be specified by the regulations. The owner will collect, compile, process and store data as referred and in such manner as may be specified by the regulations.
- 12. Log Book shall be maintained in each Specified Dam to record variable data and to keep record of instruction/s issued by the owner during/after inspection.
