Sub: Disposal of unserviceable Departmental materials by e-auction lying at various Govt. Go-downs spread over the districts under custody of concerned Executive Engineers of Irrigation & Waterways Directorate through the e-auction portal of "Metal Scrap Trading Corporation Limited" (MSTCL), a Government of India Enterprise.

Ref: Your No. MSTC/ERO/NEW BSNS/ dated 29.10.2016 and Departmental Order No. 347-IB dated 10.01.2017.

Dear Sir,

State Government in the Irrigation & Waterways Department has decided to engage "Metal Scrap Trading Corporation Limited" (MSTC), a Government of India Mini Ratna, Category-I Undertaking, for conducting e-auction through your dedicated platform of e-auction for disposal of Departmental unserviceable articles, machineries, tools & plants, scraps from mechanical and civil works and all other equipments belonging to special T&P category lying in Go-downs of the various towns of districts.

Necessary approval of the State Finance Department to engage "Metal Scrap Trading Corporation Limited" for selling these unserviceable articles by open auction through their e-auction portal has already been communicated to you.

Finance Department has also accorded concurrence to allow "Metal Scrap Trading Corporation Limited" (MSTC) a service charge @ 3% of the actual (H1) e-auction sale value of the departmental articles.

Considering the fact that a holistic and comprehensive effort was not taken previously, a huge quantum of unserviceable materials have accumulated which needs to be disposed off upon

identification of such items and fixation of reserve prices by the internal Technical Committee for Condemnation of Irrigation & Waterways Directorate which shall be completed within this month.

The undersigned is now directed to convey that the formal approval of the State Government of the draft of the 'Selling Agency Agreement' submitted by MSTCL vide your No. MSTC/ERO/NEW BSNS/ dated 29.10.2016. Legal vetting of the aforesaid 'Selling Agency Agreement' has been obtained from Ld. Advocate on Records, West Bengal and Ld. Legal Remembrancer, West Bengal on 08.03.2017.

In conformity with your norms, the Agreements would be signed by two Chief Engineers on behalf of Irrigation & Waterways Department, Government of West Bengal, one for South Bengal Districts i.e Chief Engineer (Design & Research) having his office at Jalasampad Bhavan, Salt Lake and the other by Chief Engineer, Teesta Barrage Project, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate having his office at Siliguri.

You are hence requested to prepare the finalised 'Selling Agency Agreement' in Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of appropriate value and proceed with signing of the same as per legal requirements with due consideration that the Agreement is being executed with the State Government.

The "On-line registration" for e-auction in the portal may be done by around 20 odd district level Superintending Engineers of Irrigation & Waterways Directorate under whom various Executive Engineers carry out all financial transactions on behalf of the Irrigation & Waterways Department. However the custodian of Departmental Go-downs and stores are the designated Assistant Engineers under the control of Executive Engineers who shall act as nodal officers during e-auction process for arranging inspection of materials and lifting of sold materials.

Further to above, as discussed earlier, centralised training sessions may be arranged by you at Jalasampad Bhavan, Salt Lake and Teesta Sech Bhavan, Siliguri in order to familiarise the officers in the modalities of e-auction through your web portal for which necessary logistics would be provided.

All these may be completed in quick succession so that actual e-auction may be floated at the earliest thereafter. Necessary instruction has been issued to the Department Chief Engineers to sign the Agreements and proceed for e-auction.
