Records of discussion of the meeting of "Departmental Screening Committee" held on 27.06.2017 in the Chamber of Secretary at Jalasampad Bhavan, Salt Lake.

Agenda: Short listing of new Projects in conformity with approved additional allocation under Core State Plan in the districts of North & South 24-Parganas during the current financial year of 2017-18.

Secretary took the chair. Financial Advisor, Chief Engineer (South) and other officers remained present. The following were discussed:

1. Technically sanctioned DPR of 12 new schemes at an aggregate estimated cost of Rs 21.15 Crore, were placed before the DSC. DPR for re-excavation of Birati khal and 4 identified schemes on Birbhum are still in preparation stage.
2. During discussion it was brought to the notice of the committee that land required for construction of the 300.00 m long new flood protective embankment on the left bank of river Hooghly adjoining Fakirchand College in Diamond Harbour is not in possession with the Department as per records. It was thus decided that Chief Engineer (South) would approach the Collector, South 24-Parganas for transfer of vested portion of land if any, in favour of this Department and the Diamond Harbour Municipality would be approached to take steps for generating consensus amongst rayati plot holders so that direct purchase if required is intimated and the important project may be taken up after settlement of land related issues.
3. The remaining 11 schemes were discussed and cleared in the meeting with minor corrections and modifications.
4. Chief Engineer (South) mentioned that three additional schemes are urgently required to be taken up which are summarised below:

Brief descriptions:

- i. Construction of 30 no. drains on the right bank of Kestopur Canal in connection with beautification project (Estimated cost Rs. 0.56 crore).

- ii. Flooring and decorative work in connection with foot bridge over Tolly's Nullah near Kalighat Temple (Estimated cost Rs. 0.31 crore).
- iii. Construction of steel foot bridge over Beliaghata Circular Canal (Estimated cost Rs. 1.11 crore).
5. Chief Engineer (South) further stated that savings have been after located technically sanction of the remaining schemes against allocation of Rs. 26.92 crore approved, and hence the aforesaid three schemes which are urgently needed to be executed may included under Core Plan in this meeting.
6. Chief Engineer (South) certified that there is no duplication of proposal with other sources of funding. All the schemes have been selected on the basis of ground requirements.
7. Finally after minor corrections in nomenclature etc. 14 no. of schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 21.13 crore were approved by the DSC for inclusion under Core State Plan Budget of this Department during the current financial year of 2017-18. Tenders may be invited immediately.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks.
