Sub : Transfer of Junior Engineers.

The undersigned is directed to say that it has been noticed by this Department that a large number of Junior Engineers, who have been transferred from their present place of posting through recent order(s) of this Directorate have not joined their new assignment in spite of orders from this Department vide Memo. No. 1543-IE-2T-08/17 dt. 13.06.2017. Chief Engineers who have released all Junior Engineers under order of transfer are suffering with shortage of Junior Engineers because his fellow colleagues have not released the Junior Engineer's under their jurisdiction. This has created an imbalance in different jurisdictions of the Chief Engineers.

This non-compliance of the Orders of the Department is jeopardising the normal work of this Department in this flood season.

He is therefore asked to see that all the Junior Engineer's under order of transfer in their respective jurisdiction are released forthwith, latest by 31st July, 2017 otherwise they will be stand released from this Department without any further Notice.
