Agenda: Short listing of new projects in conformity with the additional allocation decided under Core State Plan budget during the current financial year of 2017-18.

Secretary took the chair. Financial Advisor, Chief Engineer (North East), Chief Engineer (North) and other officers remained present.

The following were discussed:

1. DPR of 33 new schemes at an aggregate estimated cost of Rs 44.84 Crore under jurisdiction of Chief Engineer (North East) and one scheme relating to Improvement of Mayurakshi-Bakreshwar Canal System in District Birbhum under Chief Engineer (North) at a cost of Rs. 54.19 crore were placed before the DSC for consideration.
2. Due to very heavy rainfall occurring in the North Bengal districts during July-August 2017, inundation flooding and heavy damages to existing flood embankments & river bank erosions have been reported. In the above backdrop, in the aftermath of floods, Hon'ble MIC and Principal Secretary of this Department visited some affected sites; and considering gravity of the damages, the allocation under Core Plan in favour of Chief Engineer (North East) was increased to Rs 44.0 crore.
3. Chief Engineer (North East) has since placed 33 technically sanctioned DPRs for undertaking prioritised schemes of permanent restoration. Considering the necessity of taking up execution of these projects in the post monsoon period and attaining reasonable progresses before arrival of next monsoon, all the 33 projects were cleared by the DSC. However, the DSC is of the opinion that prior to actual commencement of each of these 33 schemes in the field, post monsoon survey of detailed cross sections of rivers and banks will have to be undertaken and reported to the Department.

4. The scheme relating to improvement of Mayurakshi-Bakreshwar Canal system in Birbhum has been technically checked and recommended by the Committee of Chief Engineers' on 06.06.2017. The Chief Engineer (North) and the Superintending Engineer Mayurakshi Canal Circle present in the meeting certified that the technical observations and recommendations of the Committee of Chief Engineers have been complied and the DPR has been framed as per standard guidelines and drawings of the Central Design Office.
5. Chief Engineer (North) reported that one old project was sanctioned within the same reach of the present proposal out of 13TH Finance Commission grant during 2011-12, which was ultimately not implemented. The DSC advised him to submit a report on the matter before processing of proposal for accordance of Administrative approval.
6. Finally all the 34 no. of schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 98.98 crore were cleared by the DSC for inclusion under Core State Plan Budget of this Department during the current financial year of 2017-18.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks.
