The concerned Superintending Engineers and Executive Engineers also remained present.

Agenda: Clearance of new schemes for accordance of administrative approval under State Development Schemes Budget of this Department during 2018-19 out of 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of

Departmental allocation for 2018-19 and special funding approved under Infrastructure Gap.

Secretary took the chair. Financial Advisor, Chief Engineer (South West), Chief Engineer (South) & Chief Engineer (Design & Research) and other officers remained present.

The following were discussed:

1. Technically sanctioned DPR of 13 no. new schemes including Infrastructure Gap Funded schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 22.97 crore were initially placed before the committee. Further 2 (two) schemes of Eastern Circle having aggregate cost of Rs. 12.62 crore were included during discussion.
2. Out of a total of 27 Medium Irrigation schemes proposed under Infrastructure Gap funding 7 schemes have been cleared previously and 9 more were discussed in this meeting. Lining thickness and grade of concrete was modified as per the Lining Manual. In addition shuttering rate of PWD Roads Directorate @ Rs. 214.00 per sq.m. was approved in lieu of rate in the PWD Building SoR.
3. After a threadbare discussion 4 No. of schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 14.1253 crore were recommended by the DSC for accordance of administrative approval.
4. Further 9 No. of schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 21.4654 crore were cleared under Infrastructure Gap funding (Annexure-II) which shall involve partial funding out of Departmental (Voted) Budget and the balance cost to be made out of Infrastructure Gap funding in addition to original voted provisions.
5. Nomenclature of a few schemes was modified to make them commensurate with the capital works and some minor corrections were incorporated.
6. All the Chief Engineers certified that there is no duplication of proposal with any other sources of funding, and all the schemes have been selected by them on the basis of prioritized ground level requirements.
7. Finally 13 (thirteen) no. of new schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 35.58 crore were cleared by the DSC (comprising 4 no. of schemes at a cost of Rs. 14.1253 crore at Annexure-I and 9 no. of schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 21.4564 crore at Annexure-II) for inclusion under State Development Schemes Budget and special allocation against approved projects of Infrastructure Gap funding.
