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Record of discussion of the meeting chaired by the Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation & Waterways Department, Government of West Bengal on 27.05.2019 at Jalasampad Bhawan with the officials of Eastern railway and Irrigation & Waterways Directorate, on the issues of widening of existing railway bridges over river Babla and Uttarason in Murshidabad and also widening of three culverts over Adiganga Khal in South 24-Parganas

At the outset, the Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation & Waterways Department explained to the officials of Eastern Railway the urgency of immediate implementation of the proposed widening of existing two bridges in Murshidabad and three culverts in South 24-Parganas. The Chief Bridge Engineer, Eastern Railway intimated the present status of design and drawing preparation and tendering of the said schemes. After detailed discussions, the following decisions were taken:

**A. Widening of two Bridges in Murshidabad :**

- i. It was informed by the Eastern Railway officials that to facilitate widening of two existing railway bridges, respectively over river Babla and Uttarason, along Azimganj-Katwa Railway line, two diversion bridges

have been planned to be constructed by the Eastern Railway. The tenders of the diversion bridges have already been floated and the work is expected to commence in July-2019 and will be completed by July-2020. The expenditure for these diversion bridges would be borne by the Eastern Railway.

- ii. It was also informed that the preparation of design, drawing and estimates for widening of existing two bridges have also been finalised as a parallel activity. The requisition of funds for widening of the existing two bridges will be conveyed to the Irrigation & Waterways Department by the Eastern Railway by the 1<sup>st</sup> week of July-2019.
- iii. It was also resolved that a joint site visit by the officials concerned of the I&W Deptt. and Eastern Railway will take place on 30.05.2019.
- iv. On receiving the indent of funds from Eastern Railway, the requisite funds will be placed by the Irrigation & Waterways Department to the Eastern Railway within 30 days.
- v. The Eastern Railway will commence the widening of existing two bridges after the monsoon of 2020. By that time, the diversion bridges will be completed.

**B. Widening / construction of three bridges in South 24-Parganas over Adiganga Khal**

- i. The Eastern Railway officials informed that the planning and design has been completed and the preparation of estimates is in the final stages. The requisition of funds for construction of the said three culverts will be conveyed to the Irrigation & Waterways Department by the Eastern Railway by 1<sup>st</sup> week of July-2019.
- ii. On receipt of indent from Eastern Railway, funds will be placed by the Irrigation & Waterways Department to the Eastern Railway within 30 days.
- iii. The Eastern Railway will commence the execution at field level for the aforesaid three bridges after the monsoon of 2019 and the work will be completed by June-2020.
