The concerned Executive Engineers also remained present.

Agenda: Recommendation of new schemes for accordance of administrative approval under State Development Schemes Budget of this Department for 2019-20 under 1st phase of Departmental allocation for 2019-20.

Secretary took the chair. Financial Advisor, Chief Engineer (South), Chief Engineer (North East), Chief Engineer (North), Chief Engineer (West), Chief Engineer, Teesta Barrage Project, Chief Engineer (Mechanical & Electrical) and other officers remained present.

The following were discussed:

1. Technically sanctioned DPR of 25 no. of new schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 154.68 crore were initially placed in the meeting for discussion.
2. A threadbare discussion on the need and technical aspects of each of the scheme were deliberated.
3. It was decided to recast the DPR for protection work at Sulapani Ghat near Hana sluice on left bank of river Hooghly by using RCC tetrapod, and thus the schemes was excluded on technical grounds.
4. The scheme relating to procurement of pump and its installation over Cantonment khal was excluded for the time being as the civil construction work is likely to consume around two years after which the pump can be installed.
5. The Chief Engineer (West) withdrew the scheme relating to improvement of Sali Reservoir at Gangajalghati due to gross technical deficiencies which has been erroneously over looked.
6. The DSC thus scrutinized the remaining 22 DPRs' in conformity with the Departmental manuals and Codes.
7. Nomenclatures of a few schemes were modified to make them commensurate with the capital works and some minor corrections were incorporated. Cost of a few schemes was modified on technical reasons.
8. The Chief Engineers certified that there is no duplication of proposals with any other sources of funding, and all the schemes have been selected by them on the basis of prioritized ground level requirements.
9. Finally, 22 (twenty two) no. of new schemes at an aggregate cost of **Rs. 145.48 crore** as per enclosed list (Annexure) were cleared by the DSC for inclusion under State Development Schemes Budget of 2019-20.
10. Tenders are to be invited immediately.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks.

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
