



4.	Operation of DVC reservoirs in consultation with the State Government.	DVC / DVRRC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flood storage in Maithon and Panchet reservoirs is to be fully utilized as committed by DVC during 2016 (495-ft for Maithon and 425-ft for Panchet) in normal flood situation and encroachment beyond these limits upto 72 hours in critical flood situations, on declaration of emergency by the GoWB. DVC may reconfirm.
5.	Extension of flood forecasting system upto the outfall of Lower Damodar System.	DVC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Latest status may be informed by the DVC. If the flood forecasting system is already launched, then warning information for the said system may be sent regularly to I&WD.
