
Chief Engineer (South West) has sought permission vide his Memo No. 325-CI(SW) dated 10.06.2021 to accord approval for short notice e-tender for 5 works under Contai Irrigation Division of total value Rs. 405.00 lakh. Value of the works ranges from Rs 35.00 lakh to Rs 145.00 lakh He has also provided justifications for such short notice tenders. Notice periods proposed for 1 (one) no. of work of tender value Rs. 35.00 lakh is for 3 days notice period and for remaining 4 works for 7 days notice period of e-tender. Chief Engineer (South West) and concerned Superintending Engineer & Executive Engineer explained the necessity of taking up the works on urgent basis in detail. Break down of schedule for the time of work was also discussed at length.

2. It is also reported and confirmed by the Visiting Inspection Team that they have visited the worksites and recommend taking up works at these locations. Considering the urgency to complete the works before the next high tide on 26th June, the Committee is recommending short notice tender for these works, as proposed by the Chief Engineer (South West).

3. Further, keeping in view the spirit of urgency, the Committee also recommends that in case of disqualifying any bidder for not having adequate credential, the time for registering grievance to the next Appellate Authority is reduced to 24 hours, in lieu of the usual period of 72 hours.






4. As already concurred to by the Finance Department, brief referral advertisements in Newspapers may be done directly by the TIA at rates approved by I & CA Department, either directly to the newspapers or through the agencies.

5. As already concurred to by the Finance Department, effectiveness of undertaking emergent restoration works through spot bids /offline short notice tenders up to value Rs 20 lakh in each case, is recommended to be reckoned from 26th May 2021 (the date of landfall of Yaas), instead of 1st June, in terms of I & WD Notification No. 19(W)/2016-17 dated 19.07.21. These relaxations would be in force till 31st July 2021.
