ORDER

At present, purely State Funded Capital Projects, including Schemes funded by NABARD, having value of Rs. 5 Crore and above are examined and recommended for accordance of Administrative Approval through Departmental Screening Committee (DSC), by the Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers, constituted vide Memorandum No.-396-IB/IW/O/IB-Misc-51/2019-20 dated 24.12.2019. After scrutiny and recommendation of such capital projects by the aforesaid Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers, a Records of Discussion (RoD) is issued by the Committee stating the names of the schemes recommended by them for consideration of Departmental Screening Committee (DSC) to select for accordance of Administrative Approval by the appropriate authority.

Similarly, all state funded Capital Schemes , having estimated cost below Rs. 5.0 Crore are examined and recommended by a separate Directorate Level Technical Committee,(DLTC) , constituted vide Memorandum No.-03-(W) dated 07.07.2021 . The Committee issues Records of Discussion of each meeting of the Committee stating there in the details of the schemes, recommended by the DLTC in that meeting. The Departmental Screening Committee (DSC), on receiving such RoD examines the schemes for accordance of Administrative Approval.

Maintaining data, information at DLTC and Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers on the schemes submitted to them and subsequently recommended by the respective Committee by issuing RoDs, is a cumbersome process. It has been found that very often the schemes submitted to DSC do not contain the copies of RoDs of either DLTC or the Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers, as the case may be. Moreover, there is no established mechanism to let the Chief Engineers, Superintending Engineers and the Executive Engineers know about the latest status of appraisal of the submitted schemes to DLTC or Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers. No readymade data base is also available to the department on the schemes, under appraisal either at DLTC or Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers.

It is, therefore, fervently felt to launch an online mechanism to monitor the schemes under appraisal at different levels. Accordingly, after discussion a separate module has been launched in (Online Plan Fund Monitoring System) OPMS system of the Department named "DLTC & CCE". Necessary training to the directorate level officers has been imparted to get them accustomed with the online system on 14.03.2022. Henceforth, on receiving of (Detailed Project Reports) D.P.Rs at DLTC and Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers, the respective Committee will make entry of the schemes and update the status like, under process, recommended, sent back for re submission with upload of respective RoDs. The same can be viewed by the officers of directorate and department at OPMS on real time basis. This will be very handy in monitoring the progress of appraisal of schemes.

To facilitate entry in OPMS, the following two separate user I.D.s have been created, respectively for the Chief Engineer South (relating to appraisal at Departmental

Technical Committee of Chief Engineers) and Chief Engineer, D&R (relating to appraisal at DLTC).

- 1. I.D.- cesouth for the Chief Engineer South
- 2. I.D.- ced&r for the Chief Engineer, D&R.

This order will have immediate effect.
