(133+2.4729) = 135.4729 Crore in the CFY of 2022-23 is subject to availability of sufficient commitment (phasing) in AAFS module and release of fund is also depends on availability of maintenance fund with this Department. SDS Maintenance allocation 'Ceiling Limit in OPMS' will be enhanced accordingly by this Department.
