# Addendum Order

A 'Directorate Level Technical Committee' (DLTC) was constituted for undertaking independent technical scrutiny of all new capital works projects to be posed under SDS voted Departmental Budget & RIDF vide this Departments' Memorandum No. 03-(W)/2021-22 dated 07.07.2021 subsequently ammendement order vide No. 05-W/22-23 dated. 12.07.2022.

Now, it is decided in the Irrigation & Waterways Department to make the following changes in the aforesaid Departments' Memorandum No. 03-(W)/2021-22 dated 07.07.2021;

<b>3.</b> All capital works scheme DPRs costing below Rs 5 crore are required to be framed as per existing guidelines for preparation of DPRs containing recommendation/technical sanction by the concerned Chief Engineers and submitted at the disposal of the Superintending Engineer, Investigation & Planning Circle-I	<b>3.</b> All capital works scheme DPRs are required to be framed as per existing guidelines for preparation of DPRs containing recommendation by the concerned Chief Engineers and submitted at the disposal of the Superintending Engineer, Investigation & Planning Circle-I.
<b>5.</b> The Chief Engineer (Design & Research) shall authenticate the 'Minutes of the Meetings' for all schemes submitted at the disposal of Investigation & Planning Circle-I and thereafter recommend the DPRs after due modifications, if any, to the Department for placing before the Departmental Screening Committee. The remaining DPRs should be promptly returned to the concerned Chief Engineer for rectification.	<b>5.a)</b> All schemes, submitted at the office of the Investigation & Planning Circle-I will be placed in the meeting of DLTC. The Chief Engineer (Design & Research) shall authenticate the 'Minutes of the Meetings' of all such DLTC meetings recommending therein further processing of the schemes found in order ,with suggestions for modifications ,if any, and also stating the reasons for rejection of schemes, found not in order. The rejected schemes will be sent back to the concerned Chief Engineers for rectification and resubmission. The recommended schemes of value upto Rs. 5.00 Cr. will be sent by the DLTC to the concerned

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	Chief Engineers for finalizing the D.P.Rs with the modifications suggested by the DLTC, if any. The recommended schemes of value more than Rs. 5.00 Cr. will be sent by the DLTC to the "Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers" for conducting $2^{nd}$ tier checking to ensure their technical and economic viability.
	<b>b</b> )Thereafter "Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers" after due examination will send the schemes found in order to the concerned Chief Engineer with the recommendation of said Committee with suggestions for modifications, if any. If any scheme of value more than Rs. 5.00 Cr. is found not in order, the Committee will sent back such schemes to the concerned Chief Engineers for rectification and resubmission.
	c)The concerned Chief Engineers after finalization of those recommended D.P.Rs (either in SDS format with "Techically Sanctioned" or in RIDF format with "Techically Vetted") with due compliance of observations of DLTC and /or "Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers", if any, will send the DPRs. to the Department as per priority. Those DPRs will be placed for appraisal by the Departmental Screening Committee.

Other contents of the Departments' Memorandum No. 03-(W)/2021-22 dated 07.07.2021 along with the Addendum Order will remain unchanged.
