Agenda: Proposal for recommendation of 01 (one) new scheme (01 no. scheme costing above Rs 1.50 crore) for inclusion under Special Central Assistance for FY of 2022-23. Secretary took the chair. The following were discussed ;

- One scheme on protection work to the right bank of river Ajoy at G.P.-Ramnagar, Block-Ausgram-II, Dist- Purba Bardhaman under Damodar Headworks Division initially technically recommended by the Departmental Committee of Chief Engineers in their 298th Meeting held on 24.06.2022. The scheme has been placed in DSC meeting dated 15-07-2022. It has been resolved that the scheme is to be reframed in consultation with the Central Design Office, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate and to be placed in forthcoming DSC meeting.
- Now after due compliance said scheme has been resubmitted and placed in present DSC meeting. After discussion this scheme has been recommended.
- Finally, 01 no. scheme as per Annexure has been cleared by the DSC for inclusion under Special Central Assistance during the current FY 2022-2023.
