





**Memorandum**

With a view to declare the unserviceable articles of stocks and condemnable machineries, tools & plants as well as for disposal of surplus mechanical & electrical equipments belonging to special tools & plants spread over various godowns in the districts all over the State, the Governor is pleased to order formation of two Directorate Level Technical Committees for Condemnation, one for the North Bengal Districts of Jalpaiguri, Alipurduar, Coochbehar, Darjeeling, Uttar Dinajpur, Dakshin Dinajpur and Malda and the other for the remaining South Bengal districts as detailed here under below:

**Technical Committee for Condemnation for North Bengal districts** would comprise the following members:

- i. Chief Engineer, Teesta Barrage Project, I&W Directorate ... Chairman
- ii. Superintending Engineer, North Bengal Mechanical & Electrical Circle, I&W Directorate ... Member
- iii. Superintending Engineer, PWD (Roads), Mechanical Circle-II Deshbandhunagar, Kolkata 700 059 ... Member
- iv. Executive Engineer, PWD (Roads), Mechanical Division-IV Naukaghat, Shaktigarh, Siliguri ... Member
- v. Executive Engineer, I&W Dte, where the old stocks, plant, machinery, Equipment & spares (including vehicles) are to be examined by the Committee for declaring condemned or surplus/unserviceable ... Ex-officio Member
- vi. Superintending Engineer, I&W Dte of the concerned Circle ... Ex-officio Member Secretary

**Technical Committee for Condemnation for South Bengal districts** would comprise the following members:

- i. Chief Engineer, Design & Research, I&W Directorate ... Chairman
- ii. Superintending Engineer, Investigation & Planning Circle-II I&W Directorate ... Member
- iii. Superintending Engineer, Mechanical & Electrical Circle I&W Directorate ... Member
- iv. Superintending Engineer, Public Works (Roads) Directorate to be nominated by PWD. ... Member
- v. Executive Engineer, I&W Dte, where the old stocks, plant, machinery, Equipment & spares (including vehicles) are to be examined by the Committee for declaring condemned or surplus/unserviceable ... Ex-officio Member
- vi. Superintending Engineer, I&W Dte of the concerned Circle ... Ex-officio Member Secretary

The Chairman of Technical Committee for Condemnation shall have the power to co-opt any additional member.

The existing Committee for Condemnation constituted for Teesta Barrage Project is being merged with the Technical Committee for Condemnation for North Bengal districts and thus the same committee would function in Districts of Jalpaiguri, Alipurduar, Coochbehar, Darjeeling, Uttar Dinajpur, Dakshin Dinajpur and Malda comprising working jurisdictions of Chief Engineer, North East and Chief Engineer, North.

Concurrence of the PW (Roads) Department was obtained vide their No. 4T-09/13/646-R/E dated 21.03.2013 for engagement of their officers in the Committee for North Bengal. Similarly nomination of engineer expert in their field for the committee for South Bengal Districts is being obtained.

Terms of Reference (ToR) for Technical Committee for Condemnation:

- i. The committees would examine old articles of stock, plant & machinery and equipment (including vehicles) which are lying under different Godown of Divisions in the district offices of I&W Directorate and which may be considered to be beyond economic repair and issue necessary Condemnation Certificate as deemed necessary. The committee would also fix reserve price of old plants, machinery and equipment (also vehicles) in case Condemnation Certificates is issued.
  - ii. To review the requirement of plants /machinery and equipments (including vehicles) of different Divisions vis-à-vis their availability and recommend to the Government if some of them may be considered surplus along with the reserved price of such machinery, plants and equipments for disposal through public auction as per tender Rule 47(8) of WBFR, Volume-I and notes there under by the parent Division as per delegation of power under WBFR under rule 8 of App.13 of WBFR, Vol-II.
  - iii. To review the present inventory of spares available under different Divisions of I&W Directorate, their present and future requirement and recommend to the Government for declaring spares not required in near future as surplus. The committee will also fix the reserved price of the spares considered to be surplus.
  - iv. Old articles of stock (excluding Tools & Plants and machineries) may be disposed off by the concerned Superintending Engineer on the basis of reserve price to be approved by the Technical Committee for Condemnation through e-auction/public auction. Regarding selling of old Tools & Plant and machinery & equipment including vehicles, the reserve price is required to be approved by the Government in the Irrigation & Waterways Department and disposed of through e-auction in conformity with the general guidelines vide Finance Department No. 4068-F(Y) dated 25.05.2015.
2. The committees would be submitting a consolidated report to the Government in the Irrigation & Waterways Department within 6 months period.
  3. This order will take immediate effect.
