**ORDER**

**Smt. Banhi Datta**, Junior Engineer (Civil), under Irrigation & Waterways Department, presently posted in the office of the Chief Engineers' Drawing Branch, was appointed as Nirman Sahayak at Ghurisha Gram Panchayat on **24/01/2006 (F.N.)** as per order no. 201/1(6)/1B/2006 dated 24/01/2006 of the Block Development Officer & Ex-officio Executive Officer, Illambazar, Birbhum, in the pay scale of Rs. 4500-9700/- of WBS (ROPA) Rules 1998.

Having been selected in the Sub-Assistant Engineer (Civil) Recruitment Examination conducted by PSC, WB and in pursuance of Order No. 3803(87)-CIE dated – 28/12/2010 of the Director of Personnel & Ex-Officio Chief Engineer, I & W Dte., Smt. Banhi Datta joined the post of Sub-Assistant Engineer (Civil) (now renamed as Junior Engineer) in Irrigation & Waterways Department on **31/12/2010(F.N.)** in the Pay Band of Rs. 9,000/- to 40,500/-(PB-4) with Grade Pay Rs. 4,400/- as per ROPA 2009, after being released from the post of Nirman Sahayak on **30/12/2010(A.N.)** vide Memo No. 381/RUP/10 dated- 30/12/2010 of Podhan, Ruppur Gram Panchayat.

Now, the Governor has been pleased to accord approval to count the previous service in favour of Smt. Banhi Datta, now officiating at the post of Junior Engineer (Civil) in the office of the Chief Engineers' Drawing Branch under Irrigation & Waterways Department, for rendering service as Nirman Sahayak for the period from **24/01/2006 (F.N.) to 30/12/2010 (A.N.)** alongwith her present service for pensionary benefit only subject to service verification entries in Service Book for the period from 01/04/2008 to 30/06/2009, in terms of Finance (Pension) Department's Memorandum No 249-F (Pen) Dated: 27/05/2019 read with Rule 33(2) of D.C.R.B. Rules' 1971.

However, the previous service of Smt. Banhi Datta cannot be counted for seniority and MCAS benefit, for her present service, in West Bengal Engineering Services.
