Separate tenders are nereby invited by the Superintending Engineer, Mayurakshi Canal Circle, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate on behalf of the Governor of West Bengal through electronic tender. (e-tender) under single stage two part e-Procurement System (Part I: Techno-commercial bid and Part II: Financial bid) for the 'LIST OF WORKS' given in next page from eligible Bonafide contractors/agencies/bidders having desired Prequalification eligibility credential for execution of works of similar nature and requisite financial capability. The technical bid in Part-I would require the bidder to only qualify for the next stage and the Part-II comprising financial bid would determine final selection of bidder for execution of the work.

After obtaining the Class 2 or Class 3 Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from any of the above CA, they are required to register the fact of possessing the DSC through a registration system available in the above mentioned websites. A list of such licensed CAs' is also available in the CCA website cca.gov.in. Last date & time of submission of bid electronically, is on 13.10.2017 till 17:00 Hours IST.

The applicant bidders/contractors must read carefully all the 'Terms & Conditions' contained in this e-Notice Inviting Tender (e-NIT). He/she should particularly go through the Pre-qualification (PQ) works & financial eligibility criteria, and satisfy himself/herself of all the mandatory requirements. Bidders desirous of participating in the e-tender should submit bids for the work only if they fulfill the minimum PQ eligibility criteria and are in possession of all the required PQ documents in original.

22. Withdrawal of bid in a Tender

Withdrawal of e-Tender once the bid has been submitted online and after passing of end date for submission and has been accepted for further processing, is not allowed. EMD will be forfeited by the Government and the L1 bidder/contractor penalised in terms of clause 9 referred earlier would be applicable.
