

- Notice Inviting Tender No : 04 of 2020-21 of Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Bankura**

1. Separate sealed tenders in printed form are invited by the Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Bankura, on behalf of the Governor of West Bengal, for the works as per list attached herewith from time to time contractors/bidders/ Authorized dealer / Authorized service provider, West Bengal Registered Co-operative Societies, Consortiums and Partnership firms registered with the State Government and contractors/bidders of equivalent grade or Class registered with the Union Government / Military Engineering Services / Indian Railways for execution of Civil / M/E works are eligible to participate depending on the criteria as laid down in the subsequent para/clause. Joint Venture firms are not eligible to participate in tenders.
2. a) Separate Tender should be submitted for each work as per attached list, in sealed cover Super scribbling the name of the work on the envelope and addressed to the proper authority.
- b) Submission of tender by post is not allowed.
3. The tender documents and other relevant particulars (if any) may be seen by the intending tenders or by their duly authorized representatives during office hours between 11:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. on every working day, till 26.11.2020 in the office of the Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Bankura.
4. a. Intending tenders should apply for tender papers in their respective letter heads enclosing self attested copies of the following documents, originals of which and other documents like Registered partnership firms etc. are to be produced on demand, as well as during interview(if any).
- ii) PT clearance certificates and latest IT return, Labour license, entity valid Partnership Deed, Form-VII/ Memorandum of Registration of Firms, as applicable), GSTIN registration certificate as per GST Act 2017, PAN valid least up to the date of opening of the tenders Application for such clearance addressed to the competent authority, subject to production of authentication receipt, may also be considered.
- iii) Completion certificates showing number and value of works presently under execution by the tenderer under the irrigation & Waterways Department/Organizations as stated in paragraph 4(b) hereunder.
- iv) A statement showing number and value of works executed under public works & public works (Roads) Department Public health Engineering, Department, Sundarbans Affairs Department & other State Govt. Departmental works executed under Public Works & Irrigation departments of Central Govt. and organizations like Railways, KPT, and Makinson Burn Ltd, Westinghouse Zilla Parishad, WBEDC, WBIICO, WBM&A, KMC, HRB, Engineering Department, Central Engineers & other Divisionsal Engineers Of the respective state/ central Govt. Department Engineers Ltd, may also be considered. Completion certificates are to be countersigned by the Executive/ Mackinson Burn Ltd, Westinghouse Zilla Parishad, WBEDC, WBIICO, WBM&A, KMC, HRB, Engineering Department of Central Govt. and other Divisionsal Engineers Of the respective state/ central Govt. Department Engineers Ltd, may also be countersigned by some other authority. Over and above completion certificates, certificates from the irrigation & Waterways Department fallible in the bank, will have to be produced in the cases of works executed by bank stating that the competent authority regarding payment has actually been received so far for the work (even if the full payment might not have been received within two working days after the date of issue of tender paper, and copy of such communication should also be submitted to the tenderer paper issuing Authority within the same period, failing which no such appeal will be entertained).
5. Intending tenders not satisfied with the decision of the tenderer paper issuing Authority may prefer an appeal to the next superior officer. Considered Chief Engineer will be the Appellate Authority for high value tenders. Necessary communication regarding his appeal to the Appellate Authority must be brought to the notice of such Authority.
6. a. Tender paper (Free of cost) available in the office of the Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Bankura, within the specified date and time as per the notice of the intending tenderers or by their duly authorized representatives.
- b. No tender paper will be supplied by post.
- c. No tender paper will be issued on the date of opening of tenders after expiry of date and time mentioned in the notice.
7. Before submitting any tender, the intending tender should make themselves acquainted thoroughly with the local conditions prevailing, by actual inspection of the site and take into considerations all factors and difficulties likely to be involved in the execution of work in all respects including transportation of materials, communication facilities, climate condition nature of soil, availability of local labourers and market rate prevailing in the locality etc. as no claim whatsoever will be entertained on these accounts afterwards. In this connection the tenders may contact the office of the Head P. W. Deposit in favour of the Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Bankura.
8. Earnest money as noted in the list of works, in the form of other than those mentioned below, will not be accepted. The tenderer in open tender, whose tender is approved for acceptance, shall make an agreement with the tenderer accepting the deposit to be deducted under the Head P. W. Deposit in favour of the Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Bankura.



- b. Government Security / NSC / KVPs duly pledged to the Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Bankura.
- c. Crossed Bank Draft/Deposit at call Receipt, Banker's cheque of any sort of above mentioned earnest money previously deposited for other works will be considered. Tender without the specified earnest documents excepting him from depositing earnest money for the tenderer, is to furnish along with his tenders, self attested copy of co-operatives and labour co-operative. Any body desirous of exempting earnest money, is to furnish along with his tenders, self attested copy of earnest money for works in open tender, as noted in the list of work, will have to be deposited by the contractors (Bona fide Contractors), unemployed Engineers the space provided in the tender form.
- a. The tenders should quote the rate both in figures and in words on the basis of percentage above/below or at par the schedule of rate attached with the tender form and also in documentary evidence of his having done so at the time of receiving of the final payment for the work.
10. When a tenderer signs his tender in an Indian language, the total amount tender should also be written in the same language. In the case of illiterate tenderer, the rates tendered should be attested by a witness.
11. The tenderer who will sign on behalf of a company or firm, must produce the registered documents (within 3 days from the date of opening of the tender) in support of his competition to enter into an Agreement on behalf of the company or the firm under the Indian Partnership Act, failing which the tender will not be considered and the deposited earnest money will be forfeited.
12. Any letter or other instrument submitted separately in modification of the sealed tender may not be entertained.
13. The tenderer should submit a statement at the time of submission of his tender showing the technical staff to be maintained for the work, with their technical qualification, failing which the tender may be liable to rejection.
14. Conditional tender, which does not full fill any of the above condition, and is incomplete in any respect, is liable to rejection.
15. GST, Sales Tax, Royalty, Building working Cess, and all other statutory levy or cess etc. will have to be born by the contractors (he will have to produce necessary documentation whatever to the tender authority does not bind himsef to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to reject any or all of the tenders received, without assuring any reason whatsoever to the tender authority).
16. The tender accepting authority does not bind himsef to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to reject any or all of the tenders received, without assuring any reason whatsoever to the tender authority.
17. The tender will have to, if so desired by the tender accepting authority, submit his analysis to justify the rate quoted by him.
18. The tenders will be open, as specified in the list of work, in presence of the participating tenderers or their authorized representatives, who may be present at the time of opening and who may also put their signatures in the presence of the tendering authority.
19. The successful tenderer will have to execute the duplicate / Triplicate / Quadruplicate copies of his tender which will have to be obtained free of cost from the office of the Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division, within 7 (seven) days from the date of receipt of the intimation of acceptance of his tender, failing which the tender shall automatically stand cancelled.
20. If any tender withdraws his tender before or refuses / fails to convert it into a contract within a reasonable time, without giving any satisfactory explanation to the Government for order as to what further action will be taken against him.
21. The successful tenderer will have to abide by the provisions of the West Bengal Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Rules, 1972 and such other Acts as may be applicable, as will be in force from time to time.
22. Materials such as cement, M.S. Rod, R.C.C. Hume pipes, M.S. sheet piles, etc. if available in stock, will be issued by the contractor for the work works as per issue fixed by the Engineer-in-Charge. Site of issue of materials as mentioned in the list of materials to be supplied departmentally to the contractor is furnished with the tender documents for the work. Any other materials not listed therein, if issued departmentally, will be recovered from the contractor at such rates as will be fixed by the Engineer-in-Charge.
23. Hire charges for tools & plants machinery, if issued departmentally, will be recovered from the contractor, the issue Rate for such material will be fixed by the Engineer-in-Charge. The period of hire charges of all for tools & plants machinery, issued from the Government Godown will be counted from the date of their issuance from the Godown and up to the date returned in good condition. In the case of any damage, the cost of repair to such damage or replacement will be recovered from contractor.
24. In the following cases a tender may be declared informal and unacceptable.
- a. Correction, alterations, etc. if not attested by the tenderer.
  - b. i. Earnest Money in form of N.S.C./Government Security etc. not held by the tenderer and not properly pledged.
  - ii. Earnest Money in form of T.R. Challan, D.C.R. / Demand Draft, etc. which are short deposited and / or not deposited in favour of the Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division,
  - iii. Earliest Money in form of N.S.C./Government Security etc. not held by the tenderer and not properly pledged.
25. For the return of the earnest money of the unsuccessful tenderer(s) he / they is / are to apply for the same to the Executive Engineer, Kangsabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Bankura, giving the reference to the work, N.I.T. No. 04 of 2020-21 of tender, amount and mode of earnest money deposited all in a complete form. The earnest money will be treated as informal.

The said Bank Guarantee (BG) shall have to be valid up till the end of the contract/Agreement period including extended time period till 100% completion of work in all respects and shall be renewed within validity period accordingly if required. The said Bank Guarantee shall remain in custody of the DDO & Executive Engineer-in-charge of the work, which shall be returned to the bidder/contractor after successful completion of the work as per contract. If the bidder fails to complete the work successfully, this Additional Performance Security shall be forfeited at any time during the period after serving suitable notice to the contractor/bidder agency. Necessary provisions regarding deduction of security deposit from progressive bills of the contractor in respect of the tendered work shall be governed as per relevant clauses of the tender contract/Agreement of security deposit from office due to this Additional Performance Security.

The Additional Performance Security shall have to be submitted by the selected L1 bidder after issuance of Letter of Acceptance / Letter of Invitation (LOI) within next seven working days and before issuance of Award of Contract (AoC) in the form of "Bank Guarantee" of any Scheduled Bank approved by RBI, payable at Kolkata or / in West Bengal, as per specimen format Form-G. Else, its/their Earliest Money Deposit (EMD) will be forfeited without any prejudice by the Tender inviting authority and the defaulting bidder also shall be liable to pay double amount i.e. 10% of the L1 bid price.

Tender BOQ of below by the tenderer BOQ. This Additional Performance Security shall be obtained only from the successful L1 bidder, if the accepted bid price is below 20% of the tender BOQ of additional performance security has been made mandatory which shall be obtained only from the successful L1 bidder, if the tendered amount i.e. 10% of the tender BOQ by the same date and time, stated before.

34. Openning of tender:- Tender will be open by the Executive Engineer, Kangasabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Banikura, or by his authorized representative in presence of participating tenderer or his authorized representative on schedule date and time, stated before.

33. Dropping of the tender paper:- Tender should always be submitted in sealed cover with the name of work clearly written only on the body of the envelope which will be dropped in the office of the Executive Engineer, Kangasabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Banikura, in the schedule date and time stated before.

32. Purchase of tender form:- Tender documents etc will be available and be issued from the office of the Executive Engineer, Kangasabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Banikura, in the schedule date and time stated before.

31. The Tenderers will have to furnish attested Xerox copies of valid I.T. (PAN Card), GSTIN certificate as per GST Act 2017 registration no. if registered, Professional Tax clearance certificate, creditinal (as mentioned above) etc along with application. No document other than original will be returned.

30. Application of tender:- The intending tenderers should apply for tender papers addressed to the Executive Engineer, Kangasabati Mechanical Division, Khatra, Banikura, depending on response to various serials in the NIT. Tender paper issuing Authority may issue tender paper for any serial even though it may not be preferred by the applicant.

29. Normally, tender paper for not more than one work in any one NIT will be issued to an applicant, who may indicate the Sl. Nos. of the work in the order of priority. However, depending on response to various serials in the NIT, Tender paper issuing Authority may issue tender paper for any serial even though it may not be preferred by the applicant.

28. As per G.O. No. 1627/8/1A dated 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2001 of Irrigation & Waterways Department, Government of West Bengal, clause 25 of tender form No. 2911 stands deleted in respect of contract of value less than Rs. 100.00 Lakhs.

27. The payment of R/A as well as final bill for any work will be made according to the availability of fund and no claim due to delay in payment will be entertained.

26. To verify the competence, capacity and financial stability of the intending tenderer(s) the tender paper issuing Authority may demand production of any necessary document(s) as it may deem necessary.

25. Money of all tenderers other than the lowest tenderer in each case, may be refunded, after acceptance of the rate in the comparative statement as early as possible.
