- **22.** Tenderers should quote their ratesboth figures and words in terms of overall percentage, "below" or "above" or "at par" with the price schedule both in the page no. 3A of W.B.F 2911andthelastpage of priceschedule.
- 23. Anytendercontainingover writingisliableto berejected.
- **24.** All corrections are to be attested under the dated signature of the tenderer.

- **25.** When a Tenderer signs his Tender in an Indian Language, the total amount tendered should also be written in the same language. In case of illiterate Tenderer, the rates tendered should beattested by a witness.
- **26.** The Tenderer who will sign on behalf of a Company or Firm, must produce the registereddocuments in support of his competency to enter into an Agreement on behalf of the CompanyortheFirmundertheIndianCompaniesorPartnershipAct,failingwhichthetenderwillnotb econsideredandthedeposited EarnestMoneywillbeforfeited.
